We are looking for enthusiastic and engaging individual who will share their passion for synchronized swimming with swimmers of all ages and abilities.

General Job Description:

- Develops and implements a seasonal training program and practice schedule for all synchronized swimmers.
- Ensures programs and schedules are appropriate for the age and skills of swimmers.
- Conducts team workouts and technical synchronized swim training for the different age categories.
- Tracks team progression and provides continual feedback to swimmers and/or parents.
- Communicates regularly with parents and Director of Synchronized Swimming.
- Oversees, supports and communicates with the coaching staff.
- Provides educational opportunities to coaching staff where possible.
- Performs various clerical duties such as maintaining attendance and reporting issues to the Board that are deemed necessary.
- Be responsible for the overall deck safety of swimmers during training and at swim meets.
- Supervises the use, safety, and storage of Sunfish equipment.
- Develops and educates self to become a more effective coach, which will include staying up-to-date with coaching certification, accepting mentorship where possible and participating in clinics and workshops that may be available.
- Attends synchronized swimming competitions as designated on contract.
- Assists and supports all team-related activities, fund raisers etc.
- Acts in accordance with the BCSSA Coaches Code of Ethics
- Performs other related duties as assigned by the Board.
