The North Delta Sunfish Swim Club is currently accepting applications to fill our Head Coach position for our 2019 summer WATER POLO program.

We are looking for a mature, enthusiastic and engaging individual who will share their passion for water polo with swimmers of all ages and abilities. Together with the other coaches and the Vice President of Coaching, this individual will demonstrate strong leadership skills.

General Job Description:

- Develops and implements a seasonal training program and practice schedule for all players.
- Conducts team workouts and technical water polo skills training for: U10/U12; U14/U16; U18
- Tracks progression and together with coaches provides continual feedback to players and/or parents.
- Communicates regularly with water polo parents.
- Oversees, supports and communicates with the coaching staff.
- Provides educational opportunities to coaching staff where possible.
- Attends and be active at meetings with both Director of Water Polo and VP Coaching, while representing water polo players and coaches.
- Performs various clerical duties such as maintaining attendance, creating team rosters and reporting issues to the Director of Water Polo that are deemed necessary.
- Be responsible for the overall deck safety of players during training and at tournaments/games.
- Supervises the use, safety, and storage of Sunfish equipment.
- Develops and educates self to become a more effective coach, which will include staying up-to-date with coaching certification, accepting mentorship where possible and participating in clinics and workshops that may be available.
- Attends tournaments and games as designated on contract.
- Assists and supports all team-related activities, fund raisers etc.
- Acts in accordance with the BCSSA Coaches Code of Ethics
- Performs other related duties as assigned by the Board.
