Job Overview

Being an enthusiastic, fun, and engaging member of the coaching team, Coach(es) will work with the Head and Assistant Head Coach, to develop of various levels of swimmer(s) as well as mentor Coaches-in-Training. We look for coaches that are passionate about swimming and that can be a positive role model to swimmers of CRSK by adhering to the values of the Club & Executive. The coaching team will reflect these values during practice sessions and meet competitions by providing an engaging and appropriate learning environment while striving to be active leaders to swimmers. Coaches will prepare for and lead practice sessions, coach at meet competitions, and attend meetings with the Board as needed.

Duties & Responsibilities

- Promote positive interactions by maintaining a professional working relationship with all coaching staff, executive members, and parents.
 - As part of the Coaching team, coordinate, supervise, instruct and coach swimmers at scheduled training sessions and competitions
 - Take direction from Head Coach & feedback provided by other coaching staff/volunteers & the Executive
 - Assist in preparation of annual club swimming plan including fun activities
 - Assist in development and implementation of individual swimmer performance plans
 - Assist in planning & implementation of a training & practice plan to include stroke, turn and block start clinics
 - Mentor Coaches-in-Training by integrating them into planning, as well as, training and competition sessions
 - Provide performance input to Head Coach for swimmers' semi-annual performance evaluations
 - Maintain communications relevant to coaching team including, but not limited to the 'communications board' at the clubhouse
 - With other coaches, organize & participate in fun team bonding activities to enhance a positive club culture
 - Be committed to all practices, competitions and club/swimmer activities for training & summer competition season
 - Attend meetings as requested by Head Coach or Club Executive
 - Maintain an orderly coaches' area in the clubhouse and conduct an end-of-season clean-out in August.
 - Be available for a flexible schedule that includes early mornings and weekends.
 - Any other duties related to coaching that may be requested by the employer
