OBJECTIVES OF THE VOLUNTEER RECOGNITION PROGRAM

To maintain the high standards of BCSSA.

RECORD OF AWARDS

A permanent record of the recipients of each Award shall be retained and held at the BCSSA Office.

VOLUNTEER RECOGNITION COMMITTEE

The Volunteer Recognition Committee is composed of three (3) persons:

Two members of the Executive and one Regional Director.

DUTIES OF THE VOLUNTEER RECOGNITION COMMITTEE

To receive the nominations for Awards.

To verify the eligibility of the persons/groups nominated.

To canvas or choose suitable candidates for awards.

To determine the form or type of award to be presented.

SUBMISSION DEADLINE

All Nomination Forms must be submitted to the BCSSA Office on or before July 5 of each year.

VOLUNTEER RECOGNITION AWARDS

1. OUTSTANDING SERVICE AWARD

This award recognizes Outstanding Service of active individuals within BCSSA who contributed in a meritorious way to this organization. It is recognized that all persons working within the organization give a great deal. However, this award is for the person(s) who “Contributes Exceptional Service”. This award is presented at the Annual Volunteer Recognition and Social Evening.

The following are suggested criteria for this Award:

Criteria:

- 1) The candidate(s) shall have made prominent contribution(s) in some aspect of BCSSA and contributed in multiple ways over a period of time.
- 2) Persons to consider but not limited to, are: Members from all four aquatic disciplines, Board Members, Deck Officials, Fundraising Committee Members and Provincial Organizing Committee Members; and Coaches (for non-coaching volunteer contributions).
- 3) The candidate should be a “member” or an individual affiliated with BCSSA.

Frequency:

It is possible that more than one person could receive this in any given year. The award is not presented if a deserving person(s) is not identified.

Nomination Procedure:

Submit a biographical resume of the nominee, including areas of participation and contribution to BCSSA.

Describe the specific contributions of the candidate.

Supply any other information that is deemed to assist in determining a successful candidate.

The Committee is responsible for the final selection.

2. HONOURARY MEMBER OF BCSSA

This award is presented to individual(s), companies or organization(s) not directly affiliated with BCSSA that has/have made a notable contribution to BCSSA.

Criteria:

The candidate(s) must have made a significant contribution, at the Provincial level, which meets the philosophy, goals and objectives of the BCSSA.

Frequency:

This award is presented from time to time to those who are identified as deserving.

To be presented at the Annual Volunteer Recognition and Social Evening.

Nomination/Identification Procedures:

Nominations are submitted to the Volunteer Recognition Committee.
Recipient(s) may be selected by the Volunteer Recognition Committee.
All submissions must be in to the Committee by July 5th.

OUTSTANDING SERVICE AWARD

This award recognizes Outstanding Service and will acknowledge active individuals within BCSSA who contributed in a meritorious way to this organization. It is recognized that all persons working within the organization give a great deal. However, this award is for the person(s) who "Contributes Exceptional Service".

Persons to consider but not limited to, are: Members from all four aquatic disciplines, Board Members, Deck Officials, Fundraising Committee Members and Provincial Organizing Committee Members; and Coaches (for non-coaching volunteer contributions).

The candidate should be a "member" or an individual affiliated with BCSSA.

Frequency:

It is possible that more than one person could receive this in any given year. The award is not presented if a deserving person(s) is not identified.

Nomination Procedure:

Submit a biographical resume of the nominee, including areas of participation and contribution to BCSSA.

Describe the specific contributions of the candidate.

Supply any other information that is deemed to assist in determining a successful candidate.
