TYPE OF MEET: Invitational Meet, **Heats and Finals**, 4 Events, "A" Meet

This is a BCSSA sanctioned "A" swim meet, therefore all rules will be applied as per the 2024 BCSSA Rules and Regulations rulebook, including any rules passed by the Provincial Board of Directors, which are posted on the BCSSA website.

ELIGIBILITY: Any registered BCSSA swimmer

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

25m, 6 lane indoor pool, starting blocks, lane ropes.

Colorado electronic timing system with digital manual backup watches.

The "working deck" includes the bulkhead and 1 meter on the sides of the pool, unless further defined by the Meet Referee or Meet Manager.

MEET ENTRIES:

- Please e-mail the Hy-Tek meet entry file and Hy-Tek Meet Entry Report to aquanautspres@gmail.com
- Entries must be received by e-mail no later than 7:00 PM (PST) Wednesday, July 10th, 2024. The entry fee for entries received by this time and date is \$10.00 per swimmer. This entitles each swimmer to enter 4 individual events plus 2 relays
- Best times should be submitted, but only times the swimmer has actually achieved in competition. If no times are available, submit as 'no time' (NT). Heats will be seeded according to times submitted
- No switching of events once a swimmer is entered.
- Seeding is done by the Hy-Tek MM and a minimum of changes to seeding will be done at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course only to make the meet more efficient.
- If there are 3 or more Cat O swimmers in each category, the swimmers will swim in their Cat O events. If there are less than 3 Cat O swimmers in their category, they may swim with the appropriate S age group in the available empty lanes. "O" swimmers will not displace S swimmers in the S event. This combined event will not be reseeded.

- Preliminary heats and finals:
 - Up to 4 individual events plus 2 relays may be entered per swimmer.
 - Heats will swim in the morning for division 1 thru 6 only. Division 7 and O Cat Div 8 will automatically move to finals unless there are more than 6 participants in an event. The fastest 6 swim times in the morning will qualify for finals in that event.
 - Swimmers and alternates are responsible for reporting to the Clerk of the Course in time for their race.
 - The Clerk shall announce the event at least twice, with at least two minutes between each announcement.
 - It is the responsibility of each Athlete to be close enough to the Clerk to hear these announcements and to make their presence known to the Clerk.
 - The Clerk shall not make "personal calls."
 - If the Clerk has completed the required calls and a swimmer has not checked in, the Clerk shall conclude that swimmer does not intend to compete in that event and shall replace the swimmer with the designated alternate. Should this occur, the Clerk shall call the alternate, allowing a minimum of one minute for him/her to report.
 - Once an alternate has been called, the listed qualifiers and any previously called alternate are irrevocably scratched from the event.
 - Finals in that event will swim in the afternoon.
 - Relays will not swim as heats. Relays will swim as timed finals in the afternoon.

- Relays:
 - Relays on Saturday will be **Mixed Medley**
 - Relays on Sunday will be **Mixed Free**
 - Each relay will need to consist of 2 boys and 2 girls
 - Alternates will need to be of the same gender as the person they are replacing
 - Swimmers can swim up divisions to allow for clubs to create enough relay teams
 - Relays will not swim as heats. Relays will swim as timed finals in the afternoon
 - Relay teams will only be accepted in the Hy-Tek format. Relay team entries must be submitted daily by 9:30 AM to the office.
 - Relay Entry Forms will be available from the Clerk of the Course or office.
- No charge for Novice swimmers entered in 25m events. Regular fees apply for any Novice swimmers entered in Div 1 races
- If there is a problem with entries or results at the meet, please follow this procedure:
 - go to your coach, who will then approach the Meet Referee or Meet Manager.

LATE ENTRIES AND SCRATCHES:

- No scratch meeting is scheduled. All scratches must be e-mailed by 12:00pm on Friday July 12th to aquanautspres@gmail.com. Clubs to use the KO Scratch Form. There will be **NO REFUNDS FOR SCRATCHES**.
- Late entries received after Wednesday July 10th at 7:00pm (PST) up until Friday, July 12th at 12:00pm (PST) will be at a cost of \$20.00 per swimmer. The swimmer will be entered with NO TIME and placed in an available heat (decision made by clerk of the course).
- All meet fees are due by Sunday, July 14th at 12:00pm. Cheques to be made payable to "Castlegar Aquanauts" or e-transfer can be sent to aquanautstreas@gmail.com (list Club and Meet Fees in comments).

- 8:00am Saturday and Sunday in the marshalling area
- All Stroke and Turn and Senior Officials must be present.
- Timers will meet at 8:45am Saturday and Sunday by the starting blocks.

DECK OFFICIALS:

- Sign up sheets will be located at the announcer table on the Pool Deck for Stroke and Turn, Place Judges and Timers.
- All clubs are expected to help

COACHES MEETING:

- 8:20-8:40 am Saturday and Sunday.

CHEERS & NATIONAL ANTHEM:

- Cheers will occur immediately after the Coaches Meeting ends at 8:40am each day.
- Anthems will occur immediately after the Cheers on Saturday

MARSHALLING:**Marshalling for Divisions 1 to 4:**

- Swimmers will be marshalled outside on the southeast corner of the pool.
- Calling of the meet will follow the BCSSA policy regarding marshalling calls.
- Events will be called 2 times with 2 minutes between each announcement
- Divisions 1 to 4 must go to Marshalling for each event.

Marshalling for Divisions 5 to 8:

- We will be using the "Simplified Marshalling procedure".
- Divisions 5 to 8 will NOT be marshalled, but swimmers must check in at Marshalling at the start of each day. These swimmers are responsible for being behind the blocks and ready to swim when the referee calls the race. There will be no announcing of events for Division 5 to 8.
- The Heat Sheets will be posted to allow swimmers to verify their event, heat and lane assignments. Swimmers may come through the Marshalling area to congregate and organize themselves prior to going out on deck. Swimmers will check in with the lane timers to ensure they are in the right heat

NOVICE EVENTS:

Novice 25-meter races will be held on Saturday and Sunday.

25 m Free: after 100 butterfly - Saturday

25 m Fly: after lunch - Saturday

25 m Back: after 100 freestyle - Sunday

25 m Breast: after lunch – Sunday

Any Div 1 or older wishing to swim 25M races will be combined with Novice. Novice rules apply

AWARDS:

- Ribbons for individual events, 1st through 6th place.
- Ribbons for relay events 1st - 6th.
- Ribbons for new meet records, not including novice.
- Participation ribbons and/or prizes for novice. No points awarded for novices.
- Medals for aggregate swimmers in Divisions 1 to 8 for 1st to 3rd place based on highest points earned. Swimmers must swim a minimum of 4 events to be eligible for a medal (KO Regional Policy).
- "O" swimmers will receive points and medals as per BCSSA policy.
- Point system for scoring is:
 - 1st-7pts, 2nd-5pts, 3rd-4pts, 4th-3pts, 5th-2pts, 6th-1pts

REGIONAL MEETING

There will be a regional meeting during the lunch break on Sunday, location to be determined. Each club should be represented by one club designate

CONCESSION:

There will be a concession on site each day of the meet. There will also be a grill serving Eggernauts for breakfast (7:30-9:30) and hamburgers/hot dogs for lunch (11:30 to 1:30) each day.

SILENT AUCTION, RAFFLE BOX and 50/50 DRAW:

- There will be a Silent Auction and Raffle on Saturday in the Main Lobby Area. Auction and Raffle closes at 2:00pm.
- 50/50 ticket will be sold on Saturday and Sunday. Draw will take place on Sunday at 2:00 pm

MISCELLANEOUS:

- Please bring clean indoor shoes as outdoor shoes will not be allowed on deck
- Space for team tents will be available on site on the south side of the pool building
- Should the electronic timing have a complete failure and can't be re-instated in a reasonable time, the meet will go to manual timing and procedures. The Meet Referee and Meet Manager will make this decision and all coaches will be informed
- Team tents can be set up on the southside of the pool
- Mile-swim relay: as fun way to end the meet on Sunday we will be hosting the mile-swim relay. Teams require 8 swimmers to swim a total of 64 laps. Each swimmer is responsible for swimming 200m or 4x 50m. The mile swim relay will take place after the final event on Sunday.
