- Attend swim meets, track swimmer performance times, and provide feedback to swimmers
- Attend coaches' meetings and participate in team-building and club activities.
- Communicate regularly and effectively with swimmers, coaches, parents and Board
- Mentor assistant coaches and senior leaders
- Maintain up-to-date coaching certifications and act in accordance with the BCSSA Coaches Code of Ethics
- Perform other related duties as assigned by the Board.
