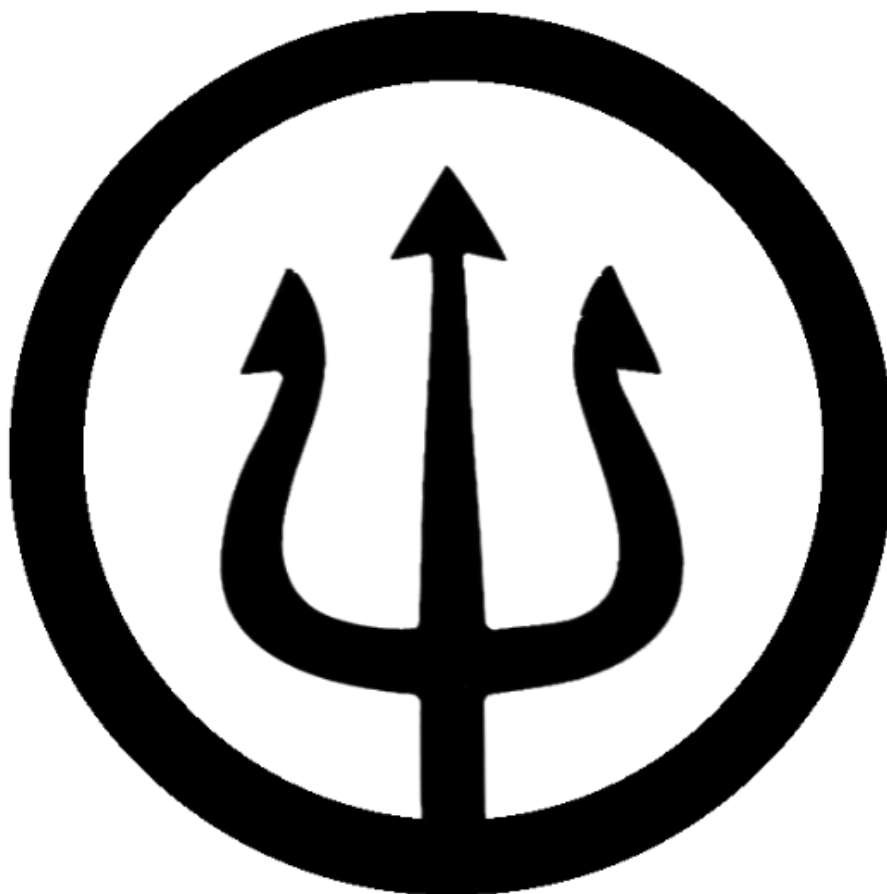


Cloverdale Tritons 2025

INVITATIONAL MEET

July 5th & 6th, 2025



LOCATION: Guilford Recreation Center

15105 105th Avenue, Surrey, BC

FACILITIES:

- 8 lane 25-meter pool (2 x 21.5-meter warm-up lanes)
- Camp will be in the underground parkade, lots of room for everyone! (**NO cooking or bbq equipment** in the underground parkade as per the City of Surrey)
- Free parking in the above ground lots (**NO parking in the underground parkade**)
- See flow chart on the map below.
- Overnight security in the parkade.

CONCESSION:

- Blenz Coffee on the second floor opens at 8am on Saturday, 10am on Sunday.
- Multiple Food Trucks on both days.

SCHEDULE:

- 6:15am to 8:00am Warm-ups - must be supervised by a coach (Lane assignments will be sent out once entries are done)
- 7:45am Coaches meeting in Marshalling, both days.
- 8:00am Officials meeting, in Marshalling, both days.
- 8:15am Cheers and Anthem, both days
- 8:25am Marshalling begins, both days
- 8:30am Heats begin, both days.
- There will be a 30-minute break with still water after the completion of prelims.
- Finals warmups will begin after the break for 30 minutes

Meet Format:

- BCSSA Rules and Regulations apply.
- Colorado Timing System
- Combined Prelim Heats: Div 1-3 & O Cat 1 and Div 4-8 & O Cat 2 heats are seeded by entry time.
- Finals for top 8 Div 1-8 & O Cat 1 & 2.
- Five (5) events and two (2) relays per swimmer (maximum)
- Relays to be swam as timed finals after completion of preliminary heats.
- All '6 and under' events will be swam on Sunday. There will be no DQ's for 6 & under events. (**by request, Div 1 can swim 25M events as an exhibition swimmer**)

- **Entries must be in by Midnight, Monday June 30th**
- **Please email entries to swalsh@scampy.com**
- Entries must be submitted in Hy-Tek format please include Team Roster.
- Provide name and telephone number of contact person and/or coach.
- "O" swimmers must be clearly marked "O" on meet entries.
- Entries with "NT" for a time will **not be accepted**. Please approximate a time for your swimmers so they can be seeded properly.
- If your swimmer requires additional needs, please contact the Meet Referee.
- **Meet Package will not be sold on site, it will be available at cloverdaletritons.ca website and heats through Meet Mobile**
- We will be accepting 550 swimmers. The team that enters the 550th swimmer will be the last team that gets to enter their swimmers.

Meet Fees

- Please note the meet fees must be paid before Sunday, July 13th, by e-transfer, treasurer@cloverdaletritons.com
- **Or, Cheques made payable to: Cloverdale Tritons Swim Club**
- Individual Events: \$10.00 and relays: \$15.00.
- 6 & under 25m Events: \$5.00 per event.

Deck entries/Scratches

- **No Deck Entries Permitted.**
- There will be no refunds for Scratches.
- Scratches must be submitted by 7:30am each day.
- Coaches must provide the names of swimmers on relay teams by 10:00 am (on the day the relay will be swum) to the Clerk of the Course.

Relays:

- "S" relays must have 4 "S" swimmers.
- "O" Relays must have at least 1 "O" swimmer.
- Relays will be swum as timed finals.

AWARDS:

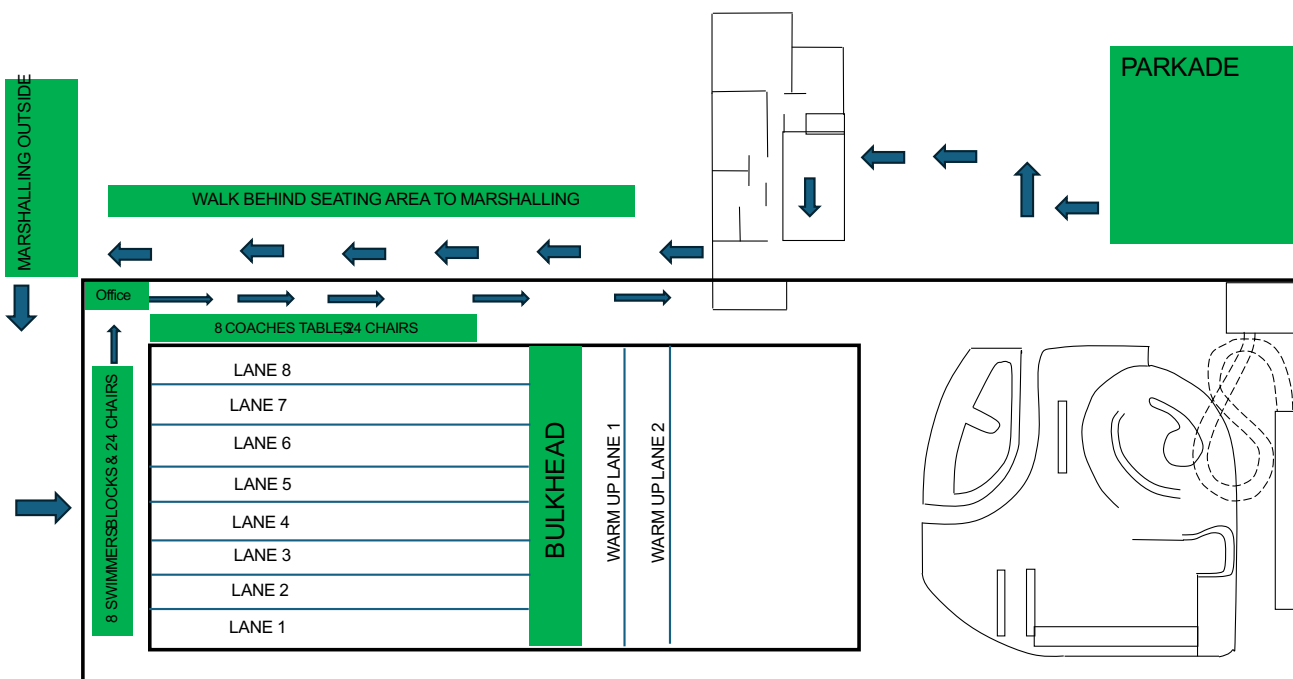
- Ribbons for 1st to 8th place for individual events & relays.

***Please note parent/family viewing will be on the balcony stands only, no one is allowed on the pool deck excepts swimmers, coaches, and officials.

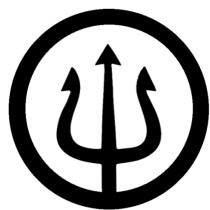
OFFICIALS and TIMERS:

Each club will be asked to provide timers, recorders and Stroke and Turn Officials. Lane assignments for warm-ups will be emailed to each club once all entries are received.

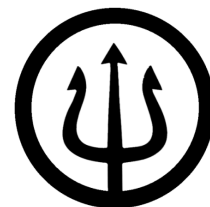

- Individual Event Prelims are combined Div 1-3 & O1 and Div 4-8 & O2.
 - Junior 50m Fly (Div 1-4 & O1) - SATURDAY
 - Senior 50m Fly (Div 5-8 & O2) - SUNDAY
 - 50m Free & 100m Free are combined Div 1-8, O1 & O2.
- All Relays will be swimming as Timed Finals.
- All divisions must report to Marshalling for Prelims and Finals.
- Coaches can sign in and self-marshall themselves for Prelims and Finals.
- 25m events are for DEVELOPING SWIMMERS (6 & under and Div 1 ONLY)
