**Location:** (See Appendix 1)

- Vanderhoof Aquatic Centre (VAC), 390 Columbia Street E, Vanderhoof, BC V0J 3A0
- 25 meter, 6 lane pool
- Club tents and day camping at the Vanderhoof arena, directly across the parking lot from VAC. Due to limited pool deck space, clubs will need to set up their day camping in the arena and only athletes being called for their events to marshalling are permitted into VAC. Athletes are permitted to speak to their coaches after each of their race events.
- There is limited spectator seating in VAC. Please watch your athlete and then leave the viewing area after their event.

**Eligibility:**

- Swimmers Div 1-4 may enter up to six (6) individual events and two (2) relay events.
- Swimmers Div 5-8 may enter up to seven (7) individual and two (2) relay events.
- Divisions will be determined by the Age Locator provided by BCSSA. This is a BCSSA sanctioned event, and all athletes must be registered with BCSSA.
- There is a \$20 splash fee for out of region swimmers.

**Race Format:**

Preliminary Races: will be time seeded. This means the swimmers will be assigned seedings according to their entry times. **All swimmers should have an entry time – coaches are encouraged to manually enter an estimated time where applicable.** Swimmers with no times (NT) will be seeded in the slowest heats. Please ensure swimmers are entered in the correct category according to the event numbers listed in the tables below.

Final Races: will be seeded by division, with the fastest 6 swimmers to qualify from the preliminary races. Final races will follow the same event schedule in the afternoon following the preliminaries. Combining of divisions in heats and finals may occur depending on the number of entries. Relays are timed finals and will follow individual finals on Saturday and individual preliminaries on Sunday.

### Race Entries:

- Race entry will open Tuesday, June 11, 2024. **All entries must be emailed to [jasonkadonaga@gmail.com](mailto:jasonkadonaga@gmail.com) by 12pm on Tuesday, June 18<sup>th</sup>, 2024.**
- Entries must be submitted through Swim Manager or Meet Manager to export the event file with all entries in the correct events. Please ensure the correct designations (“S” or “O”) and the BCSSA ID’s are entered for each swimmer with verified birthdates
- **Deck entries will only be allowed if there is an available lane in the applicable category at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course or Meet Manager. No late entries will be accepted after Thursday, June 20<sup>th</sup>.**
- Scratches- please advise crash desk by 7:45am each day on designated scratch sheets provided.

### Race Officiating & Rules:

- The Regional Director of Officials (RDO) or designate, will ensure all BCSSA Speed Swimming Rules are adhered to during the competition.
- All participating clubs must supply at minimum, one qualified official or designate an official in training to shadow a qualified official during the competition.
- Lane timing will be completed by the visiting swim clubs volunteer base. Each team will be designated timing stations to man for the entire competition, each lane must provide 3 volunteers per lane. (If this requirement can’t be met you must notify the Meet Manager by June 21<sup>st</sup>). All timers must be at their timing stations, ready for a pre-race briefing, training, and the timing system pre-race tests no later than 15 minutes prior to the race scheduled start.
  - Dawson Creek Seals: Lane 1-2
  - Prince George Pisces: Lane 3-4

- Nechako Otters: Lane 5
  - Quesnel Sea Lions & Mackenzie Rainbows: Lane 6
- \*Lane assignments for timing and warm-ups may be adjusted based on the number of entries per club

Marshalling will be announced for Divisions 1-4 with VAC and the club tenting area in the arena following BCSSA marshalling policy. Divisions 5-8 will be self-marshalled.

### **Awards**

- Ceremony to follow approximately 20 mins following the final race on Sunday.
- Medals – Gold, Silver and Bronze Aggregate Medals for Division 1-8.
- Ribbons – 1<sup>st</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup> place ribbons for Individual events for Divisions 1-8.
- All Pups will receive an award.
